THE NOTRE DAME CAMPUS

Tour the Notre Dame Campus (opened in 2014) in Fort Hill/ Highland Park, a former Anglican convent and the historic residence of William Lloyd Garrison. The campus houses 30 students committed to a living-learning experience centered on Emmanuel’s mission, reflection, urban education and service. The campus is also the hub for the Urban Food Project, which connects Emmanuel students with neighbors and community groups on issues of food availability and nutrition, particularly among low-income families. The Project includes the planting and maintenance of an urban garden—the harvest of which is shared with local organizations.
